Discover the History of Your House/Property

- What is the address of the property?
- What do you know about the house/property?
- Do you know the names of previous owners? If so, who lived there when?
- Do you have the abstract/title/legal description/tax ID number? lot/block number (city) or section/township/range (rural)
- What do you want to know?

- General search bar on top of page, enter family name(s), street address
- Records People of Burlington Vicinity, and Burlington Events
- Resources city and telephone directories, miscellaneous items including the Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps
- Gallery photos, maps
- Any other areas relating to house/property

At the Burlington Historical Society Museum/History Research Center: 232 N. Perkins Blvd Bookshelves

• Old and New Street Names and Building Addresses (Burlington city) binder - look for old address for previous owners names, did the address change in 1962 (also on website under resources/miscellaneous at

http://flowpaper.burlingtonhistory.org/AddressChanges1962)

- City directories and phone books look for previous owners
- "Houses" Binders see if there are any photos of your house
- Family Maps of Racine County, Wisconsin (homesteads, roads, towns, etc)

File Cabinets

- A-Z Genealogy/Family files research names of the people who lived in your house
- House files

Ask volunteer to access

- Tax Rolls/Assessments (City of Burlington) 1910-1997
- Plat books/maps Kenosha, Racine, and Walworth Counties

Information on houses, farms and properties show up in a variety of sources:

- Newspapers obituaries, who moved where, local news columns, advertisements
- Plats and Maps atlases, Sanborn insurance maps, Google Maps/Earth, aerial photos

- Photo collections; Directories cities, counties
- Real estate records including appraisals, descriptions (Zillow.com, etc)
- Census records some have added property details besides who lived at the address
- Family/home sources letters, addresses, address books, stories shared, estate records
- Libraries collections of books, family histories, newspapers, directories
- Municipalities maps, property tax information, links to local resources
- Historical societies, museums, research centers, genealogical societies
